Baptism is a Sacrament of our Church, that is a Sacred act (A moment set aside for my relationship with God) instituted by Jesus Christ (Matt. 28:19) that offers for forgiveness of sins and strengthening of faith to all who partake. Baptism is the property of God and is entrusted to the Christian Church to be offered to any and all who ask for it.

For this very reason, we at St. John's do not refuse Holy Baptism to anyone who requests it. But, Holy Baptism is the beginning of a covenant between God and the person baptized and the Christian Congregation! We, therefore, remind all parents that their vows at Baptism needs to be taken with the utmost sincerity. We urge them to become an active part of the 'faith community', a congregation for the sake of their lives and their children.

Member Baptisms may be scheduled during our Thursday Evening Worship at 6:45 pm, Sundays at 9:00am. Non-members need to schedule baptisms following the church service at the discretion of the Senior Minister.
